Ladies and Gentlemen:

In accordance with the provisions of the Agreed Order, referenced above, Item Number 2 – Corrective Action Plan/Engineering Report (CAP/ER), herewith we are transmitting written notification of first action on Corrective Action Plan/Engineering Report items.

1. **Woodvale Pump Station:** On May 4, 2012 a "Notice of Award" was given to Garrison Construction for the replacement of this pump station. This project consists of a new 625 gallons per minute pump station, 5,356 linear feet of 8-inch, 10-inch, and 12-inch gravity sanitary sewer, and 4,800 linear feet of 10-inch force main sewer. Once completed (currently scheduled for February 2013) this project will replace the undercapacity station, and the force main discharge will be re-routed from Basin "A" to Basin "C".

2. **2012 Sewer System Rehabilitation – Phase 1:** On August 7, 2012 a comprehensive sanitary sewer rehabilitation project was awarded to Skaggs Environmental Services. This project consists of pipe-bursting approximately 20,000 linear feet of 8" – 24" sanitary sewer main and replacing it with HDPE pipe, replacement or rehabilitation of manholes, and new sanitary sewer services. Construction on this project commenced on January 22, 2013.
